



HIGHLIGHTS OF ACCOMPLISHMENTS

July- August 2021

PUBLIC MARKETS OPERATION:

- The City Economic Enterprise – Public Market Operations are still implementing the COVID-19 Health Protocols for the market goers and market vendors/helpers on wearing of face mask, face shield, Scanning of QR Code, and Temperature upon entering the premises of the various public markets. And also, each respective markets are still doing the daily disinfection activity in the market premises to avoid contamination and to further spread of the said contagion.



- This Office also initiated a Vaccination Rollout for the Market Vendors (Category A4) in all City-Owned and Operated Public Markets to which majority of population of the said sector were already vaccinated, this program is in line with the vision of the City Mayor to attain herd immunity among Dabawenyos.



- On-going Phase 2 Construction of the Agdao Farmers Market funded by the Department of Agriculture (DA).



CEMETERY OPERATION:

- On-going 1st Phase of Construction for the Rehabilitation Project of Tagakpan Public Cemetery which composed of the 40 units of Compartmentalized Niches, Depository Building, Comfort Rooms, Perimeter Fence, and Concreting of Interior Road.



- 156 units of Compartmentalized Mass Grave Niches were newly constructed at Tagakpan Public Cemetery to cater Covid-19 related deaths in anticipation to the possible increase of fatality among the Dabawenyos who died due to the said contagion.



- Completion of 2,170 unit of additional compartmentalized niches and 3,064 units of additional ossuary niches at Wireless Public Cemetery, to which both projects are subject for turn-over from the Contractor to the City Government of Davao in order to utilize as soon as possible.



- Subsistence Operation of the Davao City Crematorium that caters Covid-19 related deaths.



SLAUGHTERHOUSE OPERATION:

- On-going construction of the Expansion of Cold Storage Warehouse and Meat Cutting Facility at Brgy. Malagos, Baguio District, this City, with an allocated budget of Php 90,000,000.00 funded by the Department of Agriculture- National Meat Inspection Service (DA-NMIS) under the RA 1194 (Bayanihan to Recover as One Act) to respond on the adverse effect of the African Swine Fever (ASF) affecting the Hog Industry in Davao City by way of preserving Meat Products in order to ensure the food security in the city.



SPECIAL PROJECT:

- On-going construction of the 2-Storey Concessionaires Building situated at the Sangguniang Panlungsod Compound funded under Supplemental Budget No.2 CY 2019 amounting to Php 8,800,000.00.
